We would like to inform all applicants that the following WSQ frameworks and/or modules are currently closed for OA until further notice. The closure of new applications allows for better optimisation as the training demand stabilises and current training needs continue to be well supported by the supply provided by the existing Approved Training Organisations (ATO). New application will be rejected.

^While the Security framework remains closed, applications for public ATO status may be considered provided applicants meet the additional OA eligibility criteria, in addition to the existing WSQ OA prerequisites set out in the OA application form.

The additional OA eligibility criteria includes:

1. The proposal demonstrates transformational outcomes for the private security industry;
2. The CET solutions are aligned to the sectoral Industry Transformation Map (ITM), if any;
3. The programme design of the Continuing Education and Training (CET) courses shows scalability to help the SMEs in the sector;
4. Training provider is to deliver value-added innovative and progressive training programmes to equip learners with emerging skills in the security industry;
5. The CET courses adopt innovative learning design which include embedding learning technology;
6. The suite of CET courses must include non-mandatory skills modules (Ref: Annex A for list of mandatory Security WSQ units); and
7. Where the CET courses incorporate usage of technological equipment, the equipment should be accessible and readily available for adoption. Examples of emerging/ advanced security technologies may include, and is not limited to, usage of smart security solutions, robotics, drones, sophisticated analytics, virtual network and augmented reality.

Specifically, these additional Course Accreditation (CA) criteria will apply:

1. The competency attained by learners should be skills-based and portable;
2. Training provider is to ensure that trainees clearly understand that the value-added contents – over and beyond the coverage in the WSQ Competency Standard (CS) – is not part of the WSQ assessment required to achieve the SOA; and
3. Training provider must not impose additional course enrolment requirements or assumed skills and knowledge, besides what have been prescribed in the CS.
